Bites/stings: Bee/wasp sting

Bites/stings: Insect bite

Colds: Coughs/flu-like symptoms

Congestion: Blocked or runny nose/sinusitis

Ear: Earache/discharge

Ear: Ear wax

Eye: Blocked ear/hearing problems

Eye: Watery/runny eye

Gastric: Heartburn or indigestion
